

The following is what you should be able to do for your Geography exam in November.

TOPIC 1 INTRODUCTION TO GEOGRAPHY: You must revise fully ALL of your Topic 1 booklet.

- State the difference between physical and human geography.
- State the 5 items all good maps should have.
- Name the six counties of N.I. and locate them on a map.
- Name a large town, including Ballymena, in each county of N.I.
- Explain what a townland is.
- State what is meant by the 'global village'.

- Name and locate the seven continents on a world map.
- Name and locate the five major oceans on a world map.
- State the differences between a continent and a country.



- Recognise latitude and longitude lines on a map.
- Define the terms latitude, longitude and hemisphere.
- State important differences between lines of latitude and longitude.
- Identify the following on a world map – Equator, Tropic of Cancer, Tropic of Capricorn, Arctic Circle, Antarctic Circle, North Pole, South Pole, Greenwich Meridian.

- Find a place on a map when given its latitude and longitude position.
- State the location of a place on a map by giving its latitude and longitude position.

TOPIC 2 DOMESTIC WASTE: You must revise pages 2 to 5 of your Topic 2 booklet.

- Draw a diagram of a landfill site and explain how waste is disposed of there.
- Explain how leachates and methane gas are created at landfill sites.
- State three further problems caused by landfill sites.
